DELAY IN PROCESSING LOTTERY BONUS TO RETIREES

The Management of the Government Employees' Retirement System (GERS) advises the retirees that there is a delay in the processing of the lottery bonus payments.

A slight problem was encountered during the processing of the payments. The payments will be processed immediately after the problem is rectified.

The bonus payments are paid to retirees who are:

- 1). At least 60 years of age;
- 2). On the retiree payroll for at least one year; and
- 3). Eligible to receive a cost of living increase by July 15th of the year in which the bonus payment is made.
